## The Cloud and Pillar of Light

"I am the light of the world." (John 8:12)

Read the story and then answer the questions:

The people of God lived in the land of Egypt for more than four hundred years. Finally, the day came when the Lord gave them freedom. They hastily went out of the land of Egypt carrying their clothes and their money, their silver, and their gold. The Lord had given the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so they let them have what they asked. They got out of Egypt with a large fortune. They were six hundred thousand in number besides women and children. They all set out on foot. This means that the whole number of the Israelites was about two million. First, they journeyed to Succoth, where they stayed for one night. Moses explained to them the meaning of the Paschal Lamb, the Pascha, and the passage of the Red Sea. "This day shall be for you a Memorial Day and you shall keep it as a feast to the Lord. Throughout your generations you shall observe it as an ordinance forever. This day I brought your hosts out of the land of Egypt, so you shall observe this day. Remember this day in which you came out from Egypt out of the land of bondage. Remember that the angel of the Lord passed over you because the **blood** which you put on your door posts was the sign which differentiate between you and the Egyptians. You are the people of God."

In the same way, the **blood** of Christ shed for us, rescued us and saved us from our sins. His **Blood** purified our hearts and gave us a new life. He differentiates us and regards us as His people.

The Israelites moved from Succoth and then encamped at Etham on the edge of the wilderness. They were on their way to Canaan. The Lord was before them in a great cloud that protected them from the strong heat of the sun and a pillar of fire appeared by night to guide them. That was one pillar of light and of cloud. Do you know the symbol of this one pillar? It stands for the Lord Jesus Christ in flesh, the light of the world. He said, "I am the light of the world."

+ Thou didst blow with Thy wind; the sea covered them. They sank like lead in the mighty waters.

+ Who is like unto Thee, O Lord, among the gods? Who is like Thee, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders?

+ Thou stretchedst out Thy right hand; the earth swallowed them. Thou, in Thy mercy hast led forth the people which Thou

hast redeemed. Thou hast  
guided them in Thy strength  
unto Thine holy habitation.

+ The people shall hear and be  
afraid. Sorrow shall take hold on  
the inhabitants of Palestina.

+ Then the dukes of Edom shall  
be amazed; the mighty men of  
Moab, trembling shall take hold  
upon them.

+ All the inhabitants of Canaan  
shall melt away; fear and dread  
shall fall upon them.

+ By the greatness of Thine arm  
they shall be as still as a stone,  
till Thy people pass over, O Lord;  
till the people pass over, which  
Thou hast purchased.

+ Thou shalt bring them in, and  
plant them in the mountain of  
Thine inheritance; in the place,  
O Lord, which Thou hast made  
for Thee to dwell in.

+ In the Sanctuary, O Lord,  
which Thy hands have  
established. The Lord shall reign  
forever and ever.

+ For the horse of Pharaoh went  
in with his chariots, and with his  
horsemen, into the sea.

+ And the Lord brought again  
the waters of the sea upon  
them. But the children of Israel  
went on dry land in the midst of  
the sea."

gloriously."

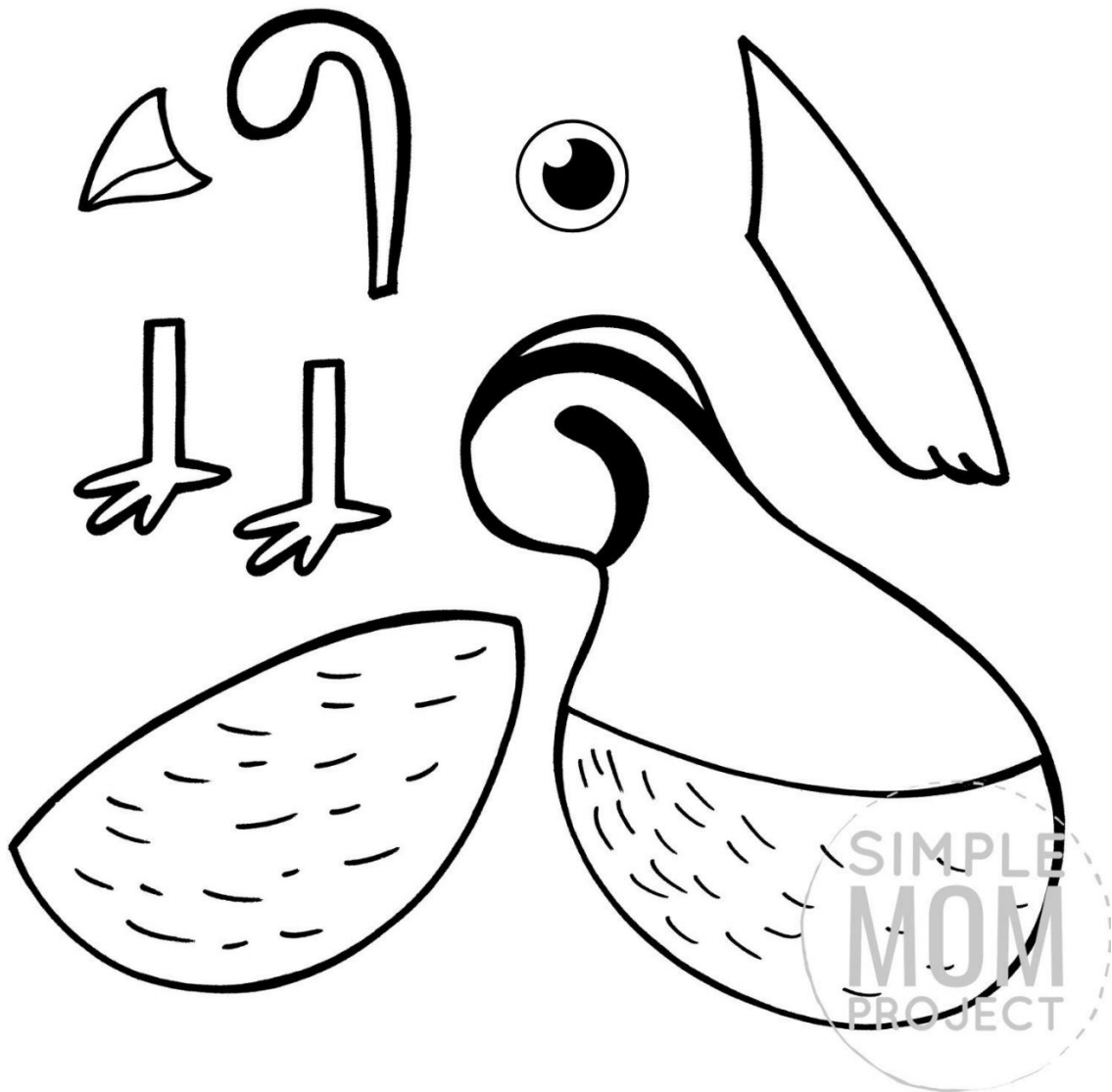

God gave Israel many victories under the leadership of Joshua and much of the land of Canaan was now theirs. But not all the land was conquered yet and Joshua was an old man. He had some final words for Israel.

## BONUS: God Sends a Raven to Elijah

"Hear me, O Lord, hear me."

(1 King 18:37)

Raven Plant Stick / Bookmarker / Puppet

Activity must be done with adult supervision (i.e., parent, guardian, servant, or teacher)

For this project you will need:

- 3 x 50 cm or 20-inch black chenille stems
- 1 craft stick
- glue gun (must have adult supervision)
- wiggly eyes
- scrap piece of yellow felt
- 3 black feathers

Time required: about 15 minutes

Instructions:

- 1 Braid three chenille stems together.
- 2 Cut a 15 cm or 6-inch piece of the stem off of the braided chenille. Curl both pieces in a snail shape.
- 3 Holding the small snail shaped curl together, glue it to the top of the craft stick. This will be the head.
- 4 Now hold the larger snail shape together and glue it below the head. This is the body.
- 5 Cut a piece of the yellow felt in a triangle. This will be the beak. Glue it on with hot glue.
- 6 Glue on 2 wiggly eyes.
- 7 Take 2 of the feathers and cut down to fit the side of the body. Glue a feather on each side of the body. These are the wings.
- 8 Glue one feather to the backside of the craft stick. Make sure that the feather can be seen behind the head.
