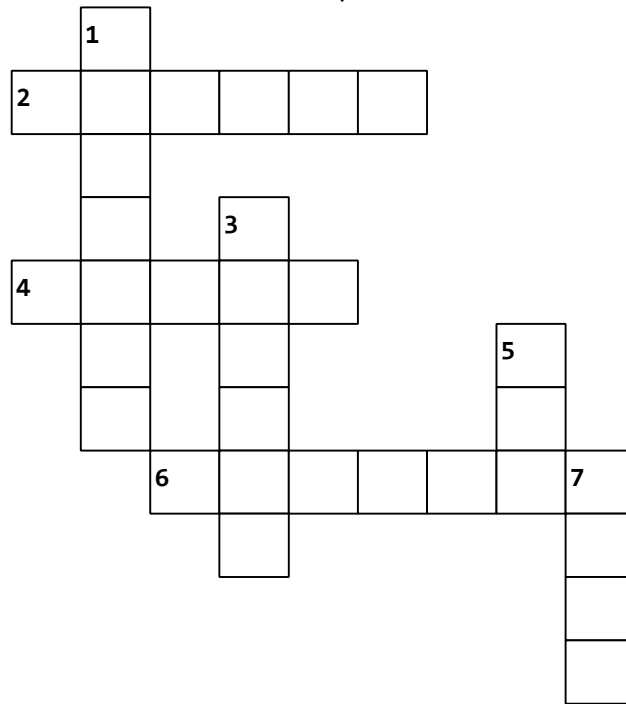


Elisha and the Jars of Oil (KJV)

1 Down	"Now there cried a certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets unto Elisha, saying, Thy servant my husband is dead; and thou knowest that thy servant did fear the LORD: and the creditor is come to take unto him my two sons to be ____." (2 Kings 4:1)
5 Down	"And Elisha said unto her, What shall I do for thee? tell me, what hast thou in the house? And she said, Thine handmaid hath not any thing in the house, save a pot of ____." (2 Kings 4:2)
4 Across	"Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, even ____ vessels; borrow not a few." (2 Kings 4:3)
6 Across	"And when thou art come in, thou shalt shut the door upon thee and upon thy sons, and shalt pour out into all those ____, and thou shalt set aside that which is full." (2 Kings 4:4)
2 Across	"So she went from him, and shut the door upon her and upon her sons, who brought the vessels to her; and she ____ out." (2 Kings 4:5)
3 Down	"And it came to pass, when the vessels were full, that she said unto her son, Bring me yet a vessel. And he said unto her, There is not a vessel more. And the oil ____." (2 Kings 4:6)
7 Down	"Then she came and told the man of God. And he said, Go, ____ the oil, and pay thy debt, and live thou and thy children of the rest." (2 Kings 4:7)
